

# La Casa de San Juan Diego

51 Townhouse Units for Archdiocesan Housing Authority  
Woodland, Washington



This Craftsman inspired Townhouse complex for The Archdiocesan Housing Authority (AHA) of Seattle, includes 51 farmworker townhomes of 1, 2 and 3 bedroom units.

The apartments range in size from 650 SF to 1,150 SF.

Finishes include natural linoleum, not typically found in farmworker housing. Heat is delivered to each unit via a gas fired "bio radiant" hydronic system that utilizes domestic hot water has its heat source.

The development was designed to preserve the significant heritage trees and open space existing on site.

Project Construction Cost was \$4.3 million including site improvements.
